


<u>New South Wales 'H' Class Firearms Application</u> <u>steps and process for new SSPC ACT members</u>


- 1. Become a member of Sporting Shooters Pistol Club (SSPC ACT).
- 2. Undertake Stage 1 Firearms Training.
 - a. This is done over 2 consecutive nights. On successful completion the Chief Instructor or Accredited Training Officer will complete and sign your NSW Pistol Safe Handling Course Completion Certificate.
 - b. Once you have been given your certificate, you can then apply for your 'Probationary Pistol Licence' via Service NSW webpage: https://www.service.nsw.gov.au

3. If you have not created an account, you will need to and follow the steps below. If you already have an account log in and follow the steps below.




NSW Training Process & Licence Issue - Flow Chart







 - d. Anything else that is required.





Once your Probationary Pistol Licence is issued you will receive a 'Photography ID' notification letter to head to Services NSW.

Once you receiving your 'Firearms Licence' card in the mail you can then begin the Stage 2 Training.

Once you have received your 'Probationary Pistol Licence' card.

3. Download or take a 'Screen Image' (of the below) and send through to the Chief Instructor and/or Accredited Training Officer. This is to ensure that you as a new 'Probationary Pistol Licence' holder; you complete the initial three (3) mandatory club shoots within the first six (6) months of being issued you PPL. This is a requirement under the NSW Firearm Regulations.

5. Once this is sighted off by the Chief Instructor or an Accredited Training Officer you will need to upload the document against your 'H' Class Firearm Licence application via NSW Police Force Gun Safe website. This informs the NSW Firearms Registry that you have completed your first part of the mandatory training requirements (Stage 2 & Stage 3) and they can begin the process toward your full 'H' Class Firearms Licence. To ensure your full 'H' Class Firearms Licence will be issued you are required to complete a further three (3) mandatory club shoots in the 2nd six (6) months before your PPL expires. If you do not complete this you will have to start over.

6. If you fail to complete the required training IAW NSW Firearms Regulations or SSPC ACT Training and attendance requirements (Stage 1 & 2) within the first 6 months of being issued your PPL; SSPC ACT is obligated by law to submit a 'Failure to Complete Pistol Firearms Safety Training (PPL) Course' form to the NSW Firearms Branch and you will be informed by the NSW Firearms Branch that your Firearms Licence application for a 'H' Class Firearms Licence is cancelled.
